Ten projects in development will be presented to industry professionals (producers, distributors, sales agents, representatives of film funds & more) at the Transilvania Pitch Stop (TPS) this year. The 12th anniversary edition of the program includes the presentation of projects to potential partners and financiers on the 19th of June, during Transilvania International Film Festival (June 13 – 22, Cluj-Napoca, Romania).

TPS aims to discover a strong selection of projects from Romania and the countries around Romania destined for European co-production such as: Bulgaria, Greece, Georgia, Hungary, Moldova, Serbia, Türkiye and Ukraine. The program aims to foster cross-border cooperation especially between the Black Sea countries and the neighboring countries eligible for the program. Over 100 projects were selected during the past editions of TPS, a lot of which were screened and awarded at major festivals around the world. This year, five projects will benefit from a tailored script consulting provided by script editor and film consultant **Christian Routh**, while all projects will be coached prior to their presentation by the renowned pitching consultant and film producer **Agathe Berman**.

Alexia De Vito (MIA|Mercato Internazionale Audiovisivo), Urte Fink (ZDF/ARTE), Hrvoje Hribar (Independent Producer) and Viorel Chesaru (Chainsaw Europe) are the members of the international jury

who will hand out the awards.

Alexia De Vito

After earning a degree in Film Studies, she worked with Teche RAI on a project to build their multimedia archive. She later joined

Cattleya as the Coordinator of the Research and Development department, focusing on script analysis and story editing for both Italian and international projects, as well as scouting for content and talent.

She then served as Head of Development and Research at the film production company Pixstar, a joint venture between Armando Testa and Pixit, founded by Fernando Ghia, the maverick producer behind The Mission. Following that, she collaborated with Fondazione Cinema per Roma, initially for the Rome Film Festival and later in the Market area (Business Street | New Cinema Network). There, she managed the Co-Production Market, first as a coordinator and later as the head of the department.

Since 2015, she has been the Manager of the Film Co-Production Market & Pitching Forum at MIA|Mercato Internazionale Audiovisivo.

Additionally, she works with Fondazione Cinema per Roma on Special Projects and coordinates the UNESCO | Rome City of Film initiative.

She is a voting member of the European Film Awards (EFA – European Film Academy) and has served on the evaluation committee for selective funding requests for minority co-production projects at MiBACT and as an External Expert for Eurimages.



Urte Fink

Urte joined ZDF/ ARTE in 2024 as a commissioning editor for international coproductions and acquisitions. Before

this role, she worked as a line producer on several notable films, including 7 DAYS (2024 by Ali Samadi, Toronto), QUIET LIFE (2024 by Alexandros Avranas, Venice Orrizonti), HOLY SPIDER (2022 by Ali Abbasi, Cannes Competition) or HOME (2020 by Franka Potente, ROME) and served as a shead of production at Detailfilm and Zentropa Hamburg, after gaining extensive experience in France, including with Coproduction Office through the Atelier Ludwigsburg-Paris program.

Urte holds a degree in Production from the film university Potsdam Babelsberg.





Hrvoje Hribar

He is a film director, producer, and writer who graduated in film directing from the Academy of Dramatic Arts in

Zagreb. A longtime professional in the cinematic landscape, he is deeply engaged with the social and economic forces shaping the contemporary audiovisual community. His body of work includes the short film Between Zaghlul & Zaharias; fiction features such as What Is a Man Without a Moustache?, The Tranquilizer Gun, Croatian Cathedrals; as well as documentaries The World Is Great and Once There Was a Man. He has also worked on numerous commissioned projects. He previously served as Chief Executive of the Croatian Audiovisual Centre and is currently preparing his next feature film Black Swan.

With extensive expertise in the field of post-production since 2000, combined with the strong IT background Viorel

Chesaru is able to help in all areas of company work. Being with Chainsaw Europe since its inception, he knows all the inner workings and all the clients. Christian Routh

Christian is a script analyst based in Catalonia, Spain. From there he works for various international

filmmakers, state institutions, and training programs.

For 15 years until 2022 he was co-head of studies of the Creative Europe supported development scheme, SCRIPTEAST, based in Poland, serving Central and Eastern European filmmakers. Over fifty feature films were produced during his time there.

In recent years he has been tutoring at screenwriting workshops in USA, Mexico, Netherlands, Romania, Slovenia, Greece, England, Ireland, and Spain, either online or in person. In 2019 he co-created and co-led an M.A. in screenwriting at Pinewood Film Studios in the UK. He has also been working regularly with national funding agencies in Eastern Europe, with events in Czechia, Slovakia, Macedonia, Montenegro, Georgia, Latvia, Lithuania, and Estonia. For 15 years he was a tutor at the Binger Film Lab in Amsterdam, and in 2012, he initiated the first HEZAYAH screenwriting workshops for the Doha Film Institute, which he led for 5 years. From its inception in 2008 until 2012 he was head of studies of a European film school initiative called FOUR CORNERS. Before that that he held the same post at the PILOTS drama series workshops in Sitges, Spain. In 2006, Christian was the co-author of a book called 'Script Development'.

Before moving to Spain in 2000 from his native London, he was head of selection at the MEDIA Programme's European Script Fund and EMDA, from 1989 until 1998. Whilst there he helped support hundreds of European films and companies, including 'Toto le Hero', 'Orlando', 'Breaking the Waves', and 'Elizabeth'. Prior to that he had been a film buyer and development executive with Thorn-EMI, Cannon UK, and Red Rooster Films.

Transilvania Talent Lab (TTL) is a training program dedicated to emerging filmmakers from Romania and the Republic of Moldova, aiming to support the development of new talents and film projects in various stages of production.

Over the course of five days, 12 selected participants will receive intensive training that covers the full spectrum of the filmmaking process. They will take part in special screenings within the framework of the Transilvania International Film Festival (TIFF), as well as seminars and masterclasses on directing, screenwriting, production, marketing, distribution, and festival strategies. Participants will also have the opportunity to present and discuss their current projects with renowned Romanian and international film professionals attending the festival.

The program is structured around three core areas — development, production, and distribution/marketing — offering tailored support and industry-relevant insights to each participant. TTL fosters close collaboration with the film industry and the educational and creative sectors, providing individual mentorship and hands-on guidance.

By offering access to essential resources, industry expertise, and networking opportunities, TTL aims to empower new voices in cinema and stimulate the creative industries in the Transilvania region. The long-term goal of the program is to become an annual, tailor-made platform that helps emerging talents build a solid professional track record, initiate new projects, and expand their (inter)national presence.



Drama Room, launched by the Transilvania International Film Festival in 2021, focuses on the creation and financing of drama series, aiming to build capacity locally.

The program is open to Romanian projects, represented by screenwriters or screenwriters/ producers, interested in expanding their portfolio towards developing and producing series and miniseries. There are up to 5 selected projects per year. Drama Room is designed to help creators develop their series production skills and understand the dynamics of the international market. The selected projects will take part in a pitching event, in front of a dedicated jury and other invited international guests.

The Best Series Award is offered by PRO TV & VOYO and consists of a **development agreement** for the project, which will be decided by the

Her career includes roles as a writer and creative producer at Zentropa, film commissioner at Danish Film Institute, founding Artistic Director of New Danish Screen, and Director of The National Film School of Denmark.

Recently, Vinca has been involved with the French Story Lab Le Groupe Ouest and Torino Series Lab, mentored Toronto International Film Festival's Writers' Studio, and serves af senior advisor to European Writers' Club. As a script consultant, her recent projects include the Netflix series Secrets We Keep and the ZDF/DR series Other Peoples' Money/Cum-Ex Files.

Vinca serves internationally as member of international think tanks and film juries, and she lectures on artistic collaboration in the development process, innovation, education, and film policy.





Gabriela Iacob

Logline:

Under the guise of a successful online appearance, two charismatic brothers, and powerful influencers, build an empire by running an underground network of human trafficking, pimping, and blackmail

Story

"Brothers" is the story of two men who use their manipulation skills, to abuse the fragility and helplessness of women, in times when masculinity is still perceived as superior, in times when modern slavery can be a game for those who hold the power.

The story will follow a young women, who is lured through the "Loverboy" method, by gaining their trust and emotional attachment, with false intentions of making her rich, and later exploited to make pornographic content and prostitution. The actions of intimidation through fear, humiliation, and blackmail are the means by which the girls are forced to perform all the services imposed by the brothers.

Elias Ferchin Musuret

He is a Romanian actor, writer and director, who graduated from the National University of Theatre and Film in 2003. Since then he has acted in many Romanian and international movies.

In 2023, he won the National Competition for Film Projects with a feature-length script followed by another project in 2024 with a short film as a writer and director.

In 2024 he participated along with other notable festivals, at the TIFF competition, in the section of "Romanan Days - Shorts" with an independent short film.

Logline

Răzvan, an aspiring actor stuck coaching at the only gym in a small town, is asked to train Emi, the awkward son of an important local figure, who needs to lose weight before his wedding in two months. But working out sucks, being consistent is tough and the pizza place downstairs smells so damn good...



"ReGym" is a heartfelt and comedic series set in a quirky Romanian gym where underdog dreams, broken machines, and complicated lives collide. The catch? Downstairs, there's a pizza place that smells way too good for anyone trying to stay on a diet. The story follows Răzvan Barbu, a personal trainer who is too scared to pursue his acting dream, and Emi, an insecure groom-to-be, forced by his powerful father, the city's mayor, to get in shape before his wedding.

They meet when Răzvan is assigned to train Emi, whose social awkwardness and lack of fitness make him a gym misfit. Răzvan defends Emi from bullies and coaches him with over-the-top motivational quotes. But his tough-love approach backfires when Emi, caught up in the moment, yells "I am the Bull!" in front of the entire gym. The scene is caught on camera and goes viral. Humiliated, Emi disappears and Răzvan loses his job. But when Răzvan finds Emi hiding in the pizza joint downstairs, he sees his chance to get his job back.

Over the course of the season, Răzvan learns to let go of his self-image as a failed actor and embrace the real connections he's built, both as a trainer and as a person, while Emi gradually breaks free from his father's control, calls off his performative wedding and begins shaping a life he actually wants. What starts as a transactional relationship evolves into a genuine friendship that helps both of them confront who they are, what they want, and how to move forward in a world that rarely makes space for second chances

The series will feature a vibrant ensemble, like an eccentric sauna cowboy, a hustling old lady selling supplements, a gym bromance, a toxic fiancée and a childhood movie hero turned washed-up creep. While taking satirical jabs at fitness culture, influencer clout and generational pressure, "ReGym" balances physical comedy with emotional growth and real themes: selfworth, letting go of past dreams and feeling at home in the most unexpected places.



Writer's short bio

Alex Pintică is a 29-year-old film editor, writer and director based in Bucharest, Romania. As an editor, he has collaborated with acclaimed Romanian filmmakers such as Tudor Giurgiu, Adrian Sitaru, Paul Negoescu, and Andrei Huțuleac. These experiences have shaped his approach to cinematic structure and storytelling. In 2022, he was nominated for the Gopo "Young Hope Award" for his debut short as a writer-director, the musical comedy "No Singing After Eight". He is currently developing new projects, working closely with both emerging and established creatives from the Romanian industry.

Alberto Niculae is a passionate filmmaker based in Bucharest, who has been active in the field of film and video production for several years, directing a range of commercials, music videos, and short films. His debut short, "5 More Minutes", has been selected in over 20 film festivals. He has been developing multiple other projects within festivals and workshops, with a notable achievement at the Bucharest Best Comedy Film Festival in 2019, where his screenplay "Silent Night" won the Best Pitch award. With a strong creative vision and a deep love for cinema, Alberto is committed to crafting emotionally resonant stories and pushing the boundaries of the medium.

Logline

Between 1992 and 1994, an accountant from Braşov named Sergiu Crişan was the owner of Alpha, a pyramidal Ponzi scheme that attracted around four million deponents and was one of the biggest financial frauds in post-communist Romania.

Story

Sergiu Crisan, 49, an accountant from Brasov, returns from Italy with his wife Violeta, who is ill with cancer. Discovering Ponzi schemes in the Peninsula, Sergiu hopes to implement one in his home town. Trying to raise the funds to get the project off the ground, Sergiu turns to loan sharks. After Violeta's death, Sergiu can no longer find a place for himself in Brasov and calls his former boss from the communist era, with whom he served time for embezzlement. His name is Adrian Iacob, he is based in Cluj and is trying to launch a new newspaper called "The Messenger". Being pursued by loan sharks but caught in a possible relationship with Ingrid, a former high school classmate, Sergiu decides to move to Cluj. Here he receives the support of Adrian Iacob and implements the "Alpha" pyramid scheme, with "The Messenger" newspaper as the main promotional medium. Sergiu is kidnapped by loan sharks to whom he owes money, but is rescued by Adrian who sees in "Alpha" a huge potential.

The system is simple: today you deposit a sum of money, you wait for 3 months and after that you will receive eight time more.

Sergiu met George Florescu, the nationalist

mayor of Cluj, and with the support of the local authorities, "Alpha" became a mass phenomenon between 1992 and 1994.

About a third of Romania's money supply passes through the Alpha system and thus through the hands of Sergiu Criṣan, and more than 50% of the population are caught up in the mirage of get-rich-quick.

Sergiu remarries Ingrid and becomes a wellknown figure, a simple man who just tries to help his fellow Romanians. The voices opposing the "Alpha" system are countered in "The Messenger" newspaper, and Sergiu Crisan's popularity leads politicians in Bucharest to consider a possible ban on the pyramdial circuit. The fear of popular revolt keeps things going, and Sergiu Crisan meets with the governor of the National Bank to set up a bank with the profits from "Alpha". The phenomenon is dubbed "The Miracle of Cluj", but in 1994 it begins to show signs of weakness, payments to depositors cease and "Alpha" system is declared bankrupt. Sergiu is arrested for fraud while his collaborators distance themselves from him. In 1995 he is sentenced to one and a half years in prison



after two appeals, and in 1996 he is released. He divorces Ingrid and refuses any contact with the press. He becomes homeless towards the end of his life and dies on the street in early 2019. The Alpha system's debt to depositors amounts to nearly \$1 billion (adjusted for current inflation). The destination of that money remains unknown to this day.

Full Moon Creative Lab is a project designed for European scriptwriters specialising in genre TV series: thriller, fantasy, and horror. The 2nd edition of the program, co-funded by European Union, consists of 3 creative residencies per year taking place in Transylvania, during which candidates will be mentored by accomplished international professionals.

The Lab aims to improve the creative process by connecting European talents across all member states and cultivating high-standards co-writing practices, with the ultimate goal of delivering first-rate, innovative and competitive European content, focused on genre series. The selected participants were guided in writers' room from the rough idea of their scripts to a comprehensive bible document, including the first season outline and a breakdown of the pilot episode.

This 3rd residency which also marks the finale of the 1st edition, will end with a pitching session at the Transilvania International Film Festival, in front of influential industry professionals, including producers, broadcasters, sales agents, TV and major streaming platforms representatives.

Producer **Eilon Ratzkovsky**, screenwriter and creative producer **Michaela Sabo** and screenwriter and producer **Arnaud Louvet** are the main facilitators of the program. The pitching session will be prepared in advance with the psychologist **Agathe Berman**. This programme is specifically designed to help creators sharpen their series co-writing abilities, in an European context.

In 2025, his music video OVERTONE won Best Irish Short at the inaugural TITE Film Festival. His short films have screened at festivals internationally. At present, he is developing a limited heist series GOODNIGHT GIRL (with Escape Pod Media) and his feature directorial debut horror SHINE ON BLACK SUN (with Keeper Pictures), both with the support of Screen Ireland.

Joona Kivirinta is a Finnish screenwriter based in Berlin. He was a staff writer on the multi-awarded crime drama Koukussa (Hooked), on the hospital show Syke (Nurses) and others. Story

Lucie Lindberg (28) is a rational scientist who lives to find a cure for progressive ossificans fibro dysplasia (FIB), the disease that killed her father. To fund research, she reluctantly travels to Grenoble, a few miles away from Autrans, her hometown.

Upon her arrival Lucie has a frightful vision of a stone monster resembling her mother. She wakes up terrified after sleepwalking to Autrans where she learns her grandfather Léon is alive and well despite 50 years with a disease that should have killed him in 10. In shock, she starts developing aggressive FIB symptoms: calcifying skin, tinnitus... Believing the cure lies in town, Lucie investigates.

Strange events keep happening around her, and Autrans blames her "cursed" family, recalling her mother Hélène's disappearance 20 years ago with teenager Giulia. The impossible occurs when Giulia, presumed dead for two decades, returns, still 17, sparking chaos and unearthing secrets.

This shatters Lucie's scientific views. The mountain's siren call lures her to the world of the Litharas, mystical mountain creatures that are in fact Lucie's kin and a key piece to the mystery of her disease and family lineage. Lucie resists, yet like those before her, she has little choice, for her refusal would mean death for everybody around her, including the one she loves.











Madeleine Féret-Fleury worked in development at Diaphana, then as a writing coordinator for several French series and an assistant director on film sets. Constantly oscillating between film, TV and literature, she wrote over twenty novels for children and young adults.

Now a Serial Eyes (DFFB) alumna, she is developing series projects for French and German companies (Audible, Elephant story, Itinéraire etc.). She recently collaborated to the writing of series like La Maison (TOP/AppleTV+) and Becoming Karl Lagerfeld (Gaumont/Disney+).

Mile Božičević is a screenwriter who has worked in multiple writers' rooms for daily TV shows broadcast on Croatian commercial networks. He won the NEM Contest for Best Feature Film Pitch and received national funding for screenplay development. A regular collaborator with Nova TV as a development editor, he is currently enrolled in the 2025 European Showrunner Programme in Cologne. He has several film and TV projects in development and is also finishing a collection of short horror stories.

Lisa Brunke is a screenwriter and dramaturg with a background in journalism and sociology. She studied film at the Baltic Film and Media School in Tallinn before specializing in screenwriting at Filmakademie Baden-Wuerttemberg, where she graduated in 2023. Her short film ,Dignity Keeper' was nominated for the German Short Film Prize, and her series ,CURED' won Canneseries Unlimited the same year.

Her work explores trauma with dark humor, through a queer, feminist lens, often featuring unlikeable female leads.

Iveta Stavreva is a screenwriter. She has a BA in Dramaturgy from the National Academy of Theatre and Film Arts (Bulgaria). Shortly before finishing her studies, Iveta began working as a staff writer for various TV projects. The last project she worked on was the Bulgarian series "Shattered Bonds", which was showcased at Berlinale in 2025. Still in the early stages of her career, she is eager to experiment with different genres. Her dream is to create the first Bulgarian dark comedy TV series.





In the last fifteen years, Docu RCB became the leading regional program for documentaries in post-production coming from South East Europe, the Caucuses, and from 2022, also Ukraine.
