First Cut Lab (dedicated to local projects) and one of the workshops of 13th edition of Docu Rough Cut Boutique will also be held under the Transilvania IFF umbrella. Year after year, Transilvania IFF grows into a bigger community of industry professionals, inspiring us to continue on our path to further develop into the first industry stop for meeting talent from Romania and the region.

Ten projects in development will be presented to industry professionals (producers, distributors, sales agents, representatives of film funds & more) at the Transilvania Pitch Stop (TPS) this year. The 10th anniversary edition of the program includes the presentation of projects in front of potential partners and financiers on the 15th of June, during Transilvania International Film Festival (June 9 – 18, Cluj-Napoca, Romania).

TPS aims to discover a strong selection of projects from Romania and the countries around Romania destined for European co-production such as: Bulgaria, Greece, Georgia, Hungary, Moldova, Serbia, Turkey and Ukraine. The program aims to foster cross-border cooperation especially between the Black Sea countries and the neighbouring countries eligible for the program. Over 90 projects were selected during the last editions of TPS, a lot of which were screened and awarded at major festivals around the world.

This year, five projects will benefit from a tailored script consulting provided by script editor & film consultant **Christian Routh**, while all projects will be coached by the renowned pitching consultant and film producer Agathe Berman prior to their presentation.

Graziella Bildesheim (MAIA Workshops), **Viorel Chesaru** (Chainsaw Europe) and **Meinolf Zurhorst** (Luxembourg Film Fund) are the members of the international jury who will hand out the awards.



Jury



Graziella Bildesheim

With over 30 years of experience in the European audiovisual sector, Bildesheim dedicated most of the last 20 years to

supporting producers who want to develop their skills and to help them finance and produce their projects internationally.

Bildesheim has developed a unique ability to detect the needs for innovative training among industry professionals; she created initiative workshops to fill important gaps in the industry training sector. Among the most important programmes she designed and led are the pan-European MAIA Workshops (2005 to 2018) which continues to hold workshops in Italy, and Hermes (2012 – 2013) for producers from Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Moldova and Ukraine. Both the EU MAIA programme and Hermes were focused on coaching emerging producers; they were supported by the Creative Europe – Media Programme and the Council of Europe respectively.

Bildesheim produced a wide range of awardwinning documentaries through her own company between 2003 and 2011. Her experience as producer, together with her creation and management of international programmes, have helped her to establish crucial relationships with funding institutions, to reinforce the importance of national and international cooperation and to expand the reach of projects and organisations alike.

Bildesheim is on the Board of the European Film Academy and has been since 2018. She is a voting member of the David di Donatello Award in Italy.



Viorel Chesaru

With extensive expertise in the field of post-production since 2000, combined with the strong IT background Viorel Chesaru is able to help in all areas of company work. Being

with Chainsaw Europe since its inception, he knows all the inner workings and all the clients. Having learned post-production at the sister company in Los Angeles, Chesaru managed to bring the Hollywood expertise to Romania. After experiencing work at the Romanian biggest two TV stations, he returned to the company he built in 2005 to add the additional expertise from the field with a mandate for company growth, both in services and in potential.



Meinolf Zurhorst

After studies of science of film and theatre, history of art, ethnology and philosophy, work as a film critic and author of several books about actors and cinema. Producer,

writer and director of several documentaries mainly for German TV. Since 1992 commissioning editor for cinema at ARTE G.E.I.E., 1994 head of the cinema department. 2000 named as head of the cinema department at ZDF/arte, 2016-2019 head of fiction at ZDF/arte. For ZDF/arte co-, executive- or associate-producer of more than 100 movies by directors like Lars von Trier, Srdan Golubovic, Carlos Reygadas, Bela Tarr, Aki Kaurismäki, Yesim Ustaoglu, Michelangelo Frammartino, Jessica Hauser, Barbara Albert, Apichatpong Weerasethakul and many others. Since 2019 work as expert for drama series and movies and as group leader at the Biennale College Cinema. In development of a limited drama series. Jury member at several festivals, permanent member of the selection committee of the Luxembourg Film Fund.



Christian Routh

Christian is a story analyst and film consultant based in Catalonia, Spain. From there he works for various filmmakers,

state institutions, and training programs. For the past 15 years he has been co-head of studies of the Creative Europe supported development scheme SCRIPTEAST, based in Poland, serving Central and Eastern European filmmakers. Fifty feature films have been produced during his time there. Recently he has been tutoring at screenwriting workshops in USA, Mexico, Netherlands, Slovenia, Greece, England, Ireland, and Spain, either online or in person. In 2019 he co-led an M.A. in screenwriting at Pinewood Film Studios in the UK. He has also been working regularly with national funding agencies in Eastern Europe, with events in the Czech Republic, Slovenia, Macedonia, Georgia, Romania, Greece, Latvia, Lithuania, and Estonia. For 15 years he was a tutor at the Binger Film Lab in Amsterdam, and in 2012, he initiated the first HEZAYAH screenwriting workshops for the Doha Film Institute, which he ran for 5 years. From its inception in 2008 until 2012 he was head of studies of a European film school initiative called FOUR CORNERS. Before that he held the same post at the PILOTS TV workshops in Sitges, Spain. In 2006, Christian was the co-author of a book called 'Script Development'. Before moving to Spain in 2000 from his native London, he was head of selection at the MEDIA Programme's European Script Fund and EMDA, from 1989 until 1998. Whilst there he helped support hundreds of European films and companies, including 'Toto le Hero', 'Orlando', 'Breaking the Waves', and 'Elizabeth'. Prior to that he had been a film buyer and development executive with Thorn-EMI, Cannon UK, and Red Rooster Films.

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Transilvania Talent Lab (TTL) aims to contribute to the training of young filmmakers, the discovery of new talents and the development of projects that come in various production stages, from Romania or the Republic of Moldova.

For a 5 days period, 13 cinema enthusiasts will be given training that covers all the steps of filmmaking. They will attend special screenings within the framework of TIFF, seminars and masterclasses on directing, scriptwriting, production, marketing, distribution or festival strategies and they will have the chance to discuss their on-going projects with well-known Romanian and foreign film professionals attending TIFF.

Transilvania Talent Lab is addressing 3 main topics, addressed to all the participants, development, production, marketing and distribution.

TTL intends to further local talent in tight collaboration with the industry, creative and educational field. The program supports local talents by using all means and individual guidance and coaching. We want to boost the creative industry in the Transilvania region by allowing talents the resources, people and knowledge to kick-start their careers, initiate and produce new projects and create or broaden their (inter)national network.

The goal of the Transilvania Talent Lab would be to become a yearly tailor-made program with which we support and co-construct a track record for each of our talents.

Set up in cooperation with the Transilvania International Film Festival (9th – 18th June 2023) this Audience development & Innovation Day Lab will focus on sharing approaches to overcome growing challenges faced by cinemas, especially in Eastern Europe, by finding creative solutions within your team and by collaborating with others.

How can we ensure that cinemas become vital spaces for audiences to invest their time in and enjoy the collective cinema experience again, despite having access to platforms and so many other entertainment options? How can we establish an ongoing dialogue with our audience and make the cinema experience diverse and attractive for different target groups? How to effectively and creatively address obstacles such as insufficient funding and staff, or outdated venues and technical equipment? What can we do collectively in case of insufficient institutional support at the local and national level?

In this practical Lab, within a festival that is committed to showing avant-garde cinema, you will have the opportunity to discuss important topics such as how to deal with very practical issues (like soaring utility costs or broken projectors), what can be the role of communication and branding in attracting a bigger audience, examples of targeting different groups through general, niche and event programming, but also what can be achieved by collaborating at the local, national and international level. You will be able to share your difficulties and concerns with colleagues and use a hands-on kind of approach to solve specific problems, exchange best practices and think of new ways of developing audiences by using innovative marketing tools. Ultimately, we hope this lab will be an opportunity to embrace a more positive, can-do mindset regarding your own venue!

The workshop is open to exhibitors from Romania and the surrounding countries.

This seminar will be directed by **Ioana Dragomirescu** (Manager, Cinema Victoria, Romania) together with **Frédéric Cornet** (Manager, Cinema Galeries, Belgium).



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Drama Room is a program initiated by the Transilvania International Film Festival in 2021, and is designed to help creators develop their series production and writing skills.

The third edition of Drama Room was opened to Romanian fiction projects (represented by screenwriters or screenwriters/producers) interested in expanding their portfolio towards developing and producing series and mini-series. 5 projects were selected.

The programme takes place between the 13th and the 17th of June 2023, during Transilvania International Film Festival in Cluj-Napoca. The workshop is specifically designed to help creators sharpen their series writing and pitching abilities and understand the international series market. The extensive 4 days programme will consist of panels led by top experts in the film industry, as well as applied feedback sessions. In the final days of the program participants will present their projects in a pitch session open to industry professionals.

Eilon Ratzkovsky Main tutor

The main tutor of Drama Room 2023 is the film producer Eilon Ratzkovsky. With a career spanning more than 25 years, Ratzkovsky has produced feature films and TV series in Israel and around the world. For the past two years, he has been a tutor for TorinoFilmLab and the Biennale College Cinema. He is the head of QUIDDITY, a content company specializing in the development of high quality TV dramas for European networks and head of studies for TFL Extended.



Saar Yogev

Producer

Saar is a A Tel Aviv University's Department of Film & TV (BFA) graduate of 1998 and 2013 EAVE alumni. Starting as a Line Producer and a Unit Production Manager in large-scale co-productions, Saar quickly gained recognition as a talented independent producer and was appointed Head Producer at Jerusalem Capital Studios for two years before returning to produce independently.

Between 2005-2007, Saar was invited to produce the Jerusalem Film Festival, after which he was asked to return to JCS, this time as Head of the Productions Division, and was responsible for numerous TV productions. In 2010 Saar co-founded Black Sheep Film Productions with Naomi Levari, quickly gaining recognition for its quality projects.

In 2018, Saar co-founded Electric Sheep GmbH in Berlin with Naomi Levari & Michael Reuter of THE POST REPUBLIC.

In addition, Saar served as head of the Entrepreneurial Producers program at the Sam Spiegel Film & TV School between 2010-2015.

Saar is a guest consultant at Berlinale Coproduction Market, Connecting Cottbus, and First Cut Lab and served as a Jury member at Film Festivals. Currently working on the production of four drama series, alongside three feature films and two documentaries.

Johnathan Young Television Drama Producer

Johnathan was most recently VP Original Production for HBO Max in Central Europe, overseeing drama development and production on Poland, Czechia, Hungary and Romania. Current and upcoming Productions include Spy/Master (Romania), Bring Back Alice and The Thaw 2 (Poland) and The Bridge (Hungary). He joined HBO Max as an executive producer in 2014 and was responsible for Mamon in the Czech Republic (Winner - Czech Lion best Drama series) and Pakt in Poland in 2015, and Pakt2 and Valea Muta in Romania in 2016. In January 2017 he took on his current role. Titles include The Thaw, The Informant, One True Singer, Hackerville (Winner: Grimme Preis), 2 seasons of Wataha (both seasons won the Polish Eagle for best drama series), Umbre, Aranyelet and Tuff Money.

Johnathan has extensive experience in mini series and returning series with a proven and ongoing interest and commitment to working in Central Europe. He has a special interest in bringing new voices and fresh stories to both a local and international audience in a popular and accessible form.



Ioanina Pavel

Creative producer

Ioanina is a creative producer who has worked on HBO's Original Productions in Europe, among which most notable are the LGBTQ drama RUXX, the reality-shiny floor show One True Singer and the Berlinale Series nominee Spy/Master. Her passion is developing scripts for series and bringing the best-told stories to whatever-size screen viewers choose to watch on. Staunch advocate for millennial-first storytelling that grabs all ages, stories that capture the zeitgeist, and dive deep into the stuff that matters.







Gabriela Iacob

With more than a decade of experience in the entertainment industry, Gabriela Iacob primarily works with storytellers and filmmakers in the fiction and documentary space. Having worked on a variety of screenplays as Head of Development for a studio company, then for an independent one, she later founded STORYLINERS, a storytelling studio committed to support independent and alternative voices while developing innovative, thoughtprovoking projects. Iacob collaborated with established writers and trained new voices covering from script doctor on award-winning features to TV series development. She is currently Head of Scripted Content Development at Pro TV, sits on the selection committee at Cinema Pendent Barcelona and is tutoring the new Mentoring Projects programme at l'AlternativaPro.



Bogdan Mirică

Bogdan Mirică is an awarded writer/director who was commissioned by HBO Europe to write and direct UMBRE (Shadows) - a series about the Romanian underworld. The project turned out to be so successful that has already reached its third season and was broadcasted in more than 20 countries, being the first Romanian project produced by HBO Europe that was shown in USA. In 2016 Bogdan writes and directs his debut feature film, DOGS – a western-neo-noir that stems from real events that he witnessed as a child living in rural Romania. The movie received several accolades, including the FIPRESCI Prize at the Un Certain Regard competition in Cannes International Film Festival, Best Foreign First Film awarded by The French Syndicate of Cinema Critics and was a nominee for The European Discovery of the Year, by The European Film Academy. DOGS was sold in over 15 territories and reached an audience of more than 30.000 in the Romanian theaters.

Bogdan's sophomore feature film, BOSS – a psychological thriller about an ambulance driver who struggles to handle the aftermath of a heist – has been released in April 2023.



Anthony Muir

The Senior Executive for International Co-Productions at Film i Väst, Anthony Muir began working with Film i Väst in 2009 and has helped provide co-production finance to more than 200 feature films. Some recent films supported include: About Dry Grasses by Nuri Bilge Ceylan, R.M.N. by Cristian Mungiu, A Chiara by Jonas Carpignano, and The Man Who Sold His Skin by Kaouther Ben Hania.

Logline:

An unhappily married couple create a group specialized in creating alibis for ones in need. With each happy client, the stakes, the money and the dangers grow bigger until their daughters' lives are threatened. When vulnerable, both parents recouple like never before to become actual vigilantes.

Story

After losing his job, Sorin, a prosecutor with a mild Tourette Syndrome is forced to jump on the other side of the law starting "a company" that builds unbreakable Alibis. He is preparing to leave his wife – Catalina – who's having sex with Alex, the IT guy – but they become his first partners in business. All three will share the cake with a corrupt but necessary MD, the same one behind Sorin's dismissal. The business works great but the spouse's connection gets more strained every day, thus Sorin decides to move in a rented flat. While attending his daughter's volleyball training, Sorin meets George – a charismatic expat posing as a sports scout for universities in Europe. George gets closer to Sorin, asking minor favors for generous amounts and bringing brazen women for a drink. Gradually, the former prosecutor discovers his new pal is a sex trafficker and, unknowingly, Alibi helped him thru one of their cases.

Nicolas can't resist being a mama's boy anymore. He runs away from home to a cult he discovered through a Facebook ad but finds out very quickly that it is very difficult for him to fit in in this very eccentric group.

Story

In a little and strange neighborhood Bucharest, Romania, Nicolas, a naive and impressionable mama's boy, falls in with a mysterious cult led by the charismatic and manipulative Lorand. As Nicolas becomes more deeply involved with the cult he befriends the other members of the cult, including the nationalist conspiracy theorist Ruxi, the alien Xiuxiu and Lola, a very smart misfit. Together, they engage in hilarious and absurd rituals. Along the way, they encounter a variety of strange characters, including a bumbling team of Vatican agents, the Pope, a mobster with a penchant for organ trafficking, other alien beings, gay Jesus and a group of geese that desire world domination. As the series progresses, the cult must navigate the increasingly ridiculous schemes of their enemies while also dealing with their own personal demons, issues and lack of existential meaning. From trying to sell fake organs on the black market to attempting mass suicide to raise money, the cult's plans become more outrageous and hilarious with each episode. Despite the absurdity of their predicaments, the characters of "Mom, I Joined a Cult" ultimately learn how depressive a life of hedonism really is, about the importance of friends and about the dangers of blind faith in a religion or in an ideology.

Alexandru Gorghe (b. 1999, Botosani, Romania) is a young writer. He studied for a BA at the Royal Central School of Speech and Drama in London (2019-2022) and now he is doing an MA in playwrighting at Ion Luca Caragiale University of Theatre Arts and Film Bucharest. He started acting, directing and writing since high school, as part of the young theatre company. So far he has written six plays that have been performed in Romanian theatre and in 2022 he published his debut novel, 'Son of Cruelty', at Creator Publishing House.
